Mentone Monster Mash: Birmingham FOOTMAD's Mentone Dance Weekend August 17-19, 2018

FRIDAY

Arrive anytime in the afternoon, select a bunk or campsite and relax. Note that some bunks are marked reserved for staff, bands, etc. Go down to the dining hall and drop off your Saturday potluck contribution with the kitchen staff along with a description and instructions.

- 3:30-6:00 **Swim:** at the waterfront, lifeguard on duty
- 7:00-11:00 **CHECK IN:** at the dance hall. SIGN UP for a volunteer job at registration!
- 8:00-10:00 **Katie's Kids' Activities Check In:** at the patio under the dining hall, for pre-registered kids
- 8:00-11:00 **DANCE:** Red Mountain Yellowhammers with caller Charlotte Crittenden

SATURDAY

- 8:00-9:00 **Breakfast:** at the dining hall. Bring your own coffee cup, please.
- 9:30-11:30 **Katie's Kids' Activities Check In:** at the patio under the dining hall, for pre-registered kids
- 9:30-11:30 **DANCE:** Count Mikula and the Vampires with caller Charlotte Crittenden
- 11:30 **Plan:** If you are doing a skit or song in the waterfront festivities, let Tom Gordon know NOW, in front of the dance hall stage.
- 11:30-5:30 **Swim:** Lifeguard on duty at the waterfront
- Noon **Lunch break:** on your own
- 2:00-3:00 **Drama:** Waterfront Festivities: Get with your pals to perform a little tune or skit
- 3:00-4:00 **Cook:** Go work in the kitchen if your potluck dish needs cooking/assembling.
- 3:30-4:30 **Mojo Boost:** blues dance workshop with Jim Bird and Diann Weatherly at the dance hall
- Slow Jam:** with JC Miller at the fire circle by the dining hall
- 5:00-5:45 **Concert:** The Onlies - at the patio under the dining hall (if it rains we move to the dance hall)
- 5:45-7:00 **Potluck Supper:** at the dining hall – remember those coffee cups!
- 8:00-10:00 **Katie's Kids' Activities Check In:** at the patio under the dining hall, for pre-registered kids
- 8:00-11:00 **DANCE:** The Onlies with Cis Hinkle
- 11:15-1:00 **DANCE:** Late Night Social & Dance with Mick Kinney & Jambiance – at the dining hall

SUNDAY

- 8:30-9:30 **Breakfast:** at the dining hall. Once more, remember your coffee cup.
- 9:15-9:45 **Sing:** Gospel singing with Janet Shepherd at the patio under the dining hall
- 10:00-12:00 **Kids' Activities with Katie Elkins:** at the patio under the dining hall
- 10:00-12:00 **DANCE:** The Onlies with Cis Hinkle
- 12:00-1:00 **Pack Up & Camp Cleaning Frenzy:** especially cabins! PLEASE empty all cabin trash cans into the big outdoor bin by your cabin.
- 1:00-2:00 **Farewell PICNIC:** at picnic tables outside dining hall. Bring your own picnic lunch. FOOTMAD provides ice, water, tea, and cold leftovers from the kitchen. Pick up your potluck container NOW. Bring your own plates and forks to minimize clean up.
- 2:00 **CHECK OUT:** You can stay later but your belongings must be out of the cabins by 2:00. Items left will be gathered as lost and found by our closing crew, unless it is your entire set up, which you may discuss later with Camp Riverview.
- 12:00-3:30 **Swim:** Lifeguard on duty at the waterfront

Things You Can't Ignore, Igor

- Registration begins Friday at 7:00pm in the Dance Hall.
- **Please remember to register for a volunteer position. We keep the cost of the weekend low** by depending on your participation in a huge volunteer task force. THE VOLUNTEER SIGN UP SHEET IS RIGHT NEXT TO REGISTRATION!
- We provide beds, breakfasts and bathrooms with showers.
- Bunks are available on a first come, first served basis. Some are reserved for bands and staff. Please respect the signs on those labeled as such.
- Cabins for families with children, for men only, for women only and mixed sexes are marked and available.
- Tent campers need to be aware of the boundary between Camp Riverview and the Cloudmont Golf Course. Do not camp on the right side of the road that separates the camp and the golf course. See map below.
- Potluck contributions, labeled with serving instructions, go to the dining hall kitchen to the marked cooler or shelf. We provide chips, salsa, and watermelon for the Potluck Supper. The rest is up to you ☺.
- **No personal food in the kitchen: keep your food in your own cooler, at your cabin or campsite!**
- Be sure to bring your own food for lunches, snacks, beverages, a generous potluck contribution for Saturday evening and food for your picnic on Sunday.
- Also bring your own sheets, pillows, towels, water bottles, flotation, and other essentials like musical instruments, picking chairs, songbooks, flashlights, extra fans, earplugs (camp is NOT quiet), bug spray, and sunscreen.
- **NO ICE IS AVAILABLE AT THE CAMP. The nearest ice is at the Mentone Market (256-634-4686) on Hwy 117** past Wildflower Café on your left as you head toward Georgia.
- First Aid Kits are located in the Dining Hall and Dance Hall.
- **Please Remember You Are Here at Your Own Risk!**
