

Hey Hippies - Tips for a hassle-free Mentone Woodstock:

- Registration begins Friday at 7:00pm in the Dance Hall.
- **Remember to register for a volunteer position. We depend on your participation to keep the cost of the weekend low. SIGN UP WHEN YOU REGISTER!**
- We provide beds, breakfasts and bathrooms with showers.
- The camp provides bunks on a first come, first served basis. We reserve some for bands and staff. Please respect the signs on those labeled as such.
- You will find clearly marked cabins for families with children, for men only, for women only and mixed sexes.
- Tent campers: pay attention to the boundary between Camp Riverview and the Cloudmont Golf Course. Avoid the right side of the road that separates the camp and the golf course. See map below.
- Potluck contributions: label each with serving instructions and store in the dining hall kitchen in the marked cooler or shelf. We provide chips, salsa, and watermelon for the Potluck Supper. You provide the rest ☺.
- **No personal food in the kitchen: keep your food in your own cooler, at your cabin or campsite!**
- Make sure you bring your own food for lunches, snacks, beverages, a generous potluck contribution for Saturday evening and food for your picnic on Sunday.
- Also bring your own sheets, pillows, towels, water bottles, flotation, and other essentials like musical instruments, picking chairs, songbooks, flashlights, extra fans, earplugs (camp is NOT quiet), bug spray, and sunscreen.
- **NO ICE AT THE CAMP. The nearest ice is at the Mentone Market (256-634-4686) on Hwy 117 past Wildflower Café on your left as you head toward Georgia.**
- We have First Aid Kits in the Dining Hall and Dance Hall.
- **Please Remember You Are Here at Your Own Risk!**

- Nearest Hospital: Baptist Medical Center in Fort Payne, AL - Emergency Room (256-997-2400). Take I-59 South toward Birmingham. Take exit 218 and follow the signs.
- Camp Riverview: Kitchen (256-634-4447), Office (256-634-4043)
- **KIDS' ACTIVITIES with Katie Elkins:** During the dances we offer bargain fun for kids aged 5-12 at \$10 per kid for the whole weekend. Check in at the registration desk Friday night. Kids' activity times (same as dances): Friday Night 8:00-10:00; Saturday Morning 9:30-11:30; Saturday Night 8:00-10:00; Sunday Morning 10:00-12:00. We have tie dying scheduled for the kids, so dress them for getting messy and bring a clean white cotton t-shirt to tie die.
- **Children must have adult supervision at the river Friday 3:30 - 6:00 Saturday 11:30 - 5:30 Sunday Noon-3:30**
- Extra toilet paper is located in the dance hall on first bench to your right.
- We recycle. Use marked bags for glass, paper, aluminum & plastics at cabins, dance hall and dining hall.
- Please take lost and found items to the dining hall with a note stating where they were found.
- **Bring your own coffee cup to meals in the dining hall, and your own water bottle to the dance hall.**
- Quote from the Camp Riverview contract - "The rental group agrees to have no alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, fireworks or firearms on camp property."
- **SUNDAY CABIN CHECKOUT** - Your personal belongings must be out of the cabin by 2:00.
