

## **Dance Weekend at Camp Skyline [4888 AL-117, Mentone, AL 35984] What you need to know before hand and when you arrive!**

### **COVID issues:**

- Refer to our [COVID policy](#) for the Mentone Weekend.
- Basically, if you've tested positive in the interval of August 14-19 or feel sick on August 19th, then stay home and isolate.

### **We suggest that you bring:**

- Camp chair for attending various activities such as the Mentone Song Celebration, the Saturday afternoon concert, and impromptu gatherings
- Your desired bedding and towels
- Water bottle!! [Or you can purchase a FOOTMAD reusable bottle for \$5.]
- Coffee cup/mug
- A snack or two (individually wrapped) to share with others at the dances (we will have a snack table set up on the dance hall's back porch)
- A favorite dance weekend name button (or two) to use
- If you bring a fan, battery operated would be nice so as not to overload the cabin circuits
- A flashlight is also handy to have when heading back to your cabin at night from the dance hall.

### **Lodging options:**

There are enough beds to sleep over 300 people on campus! Plenty of room to spread out!

- Hut Row (closest to dance hall and dining hall) This area has 6 cabins, each with 8 to 9 bunk beds; 3 'counselor' rooms with either single or bunk beds, and 2 bathrooms with toilet, sink and shower. No A/C but ceiling fans in large room. One cabin for men only and one cabin for women only.
- Lodge - (next closest to dance & dining halls, next to Art Center) It has 5 cabin areas (2 downstairs and 3 upstairs), each with 8 bunk beds, 2 'counselor' rooms with single beds, and bathrooms. No A/C but ceiling fans in large room.
- Riverside (farthest from all activity areas - at least a 5 minute walk) - 23 rooms (8 downstairs and 15 upstairs) with 2 to 3 bunk beds each, and private bathroom with toilet, sink and shower. No A/C but ceiling fans.

### **Parking options:**

- The main parking lot off AL Hwy 117 by the office may be best for those not staying 'on campus' the whole time.
- The additional parking (on half the tennis courts next to the dining hall) will be best for those staying 'on campus' the entire time. This is accessed via the camp gate on County Road 631
- For those staying at Riverside, parking is allowed along the drive circling the building. NO Parking on the field!

### **How to access camp areas when arriving:**

- Main entrance: If driving east on AL 117 having gone thru Mentone, turn left into the camp's main parking lot after crossing the bridge. If driving west on AL 117, it will be a right turn after CR 631. If you get to the bridge you have gone too far.
- Additional parking entrance: If driving east on AL 117, go past the main camp entrance and turn left CR 631. If driving west on AL 117, turn right on CR 631. Then turn left into the camp via the gated entrance. Turn left before the dining hall and then left onto the tennis courts to park.
- Riverside entrance: If driving east on AL 117, go past the Moon Lake Trading Co (on the left after Dempsey St) and turn left at Lake St then turn right onto the Riverside drive. If driving west on AL 117, go past the main camp entrance, cross the bridge and turn right at Lake St. then turn right onto the Riverside drive. There will be a sign indicating Riverside that can be seen from AL 117.
